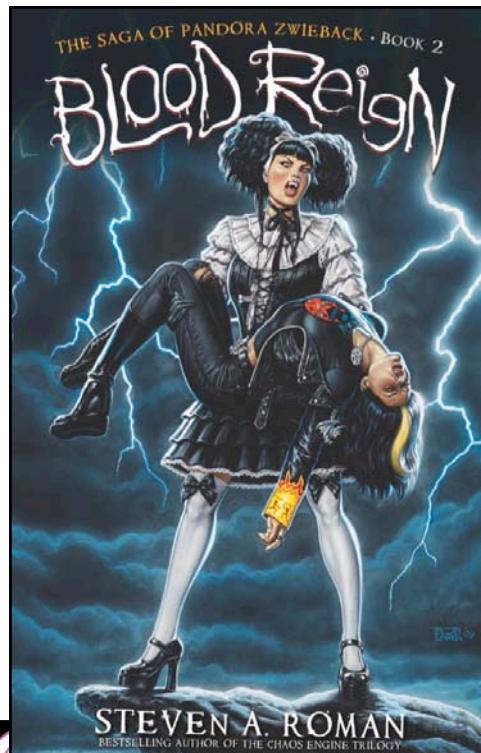

And now things *really* start to heat up! After successfully launching in 2011 with *Blood Feud*—the first novel in the dark-fantasy series *The Saga of Pandora Zwieback*—the illustrated classic *Carmilla*, and *The Bob Larkin Sketchbook*, we here at The 'Warp are ready for Stage 2.

We kick off 2012 with our second illustrated classic: Edgar Rice Burroughs's *A Princess of Mars*, the first novel in his famous "John Carter of Mars" series. Not only is February 2012 *Princess's* 100th Anniversary, but a major motion picture adaptation is on the way, with Disney's *John Carter* scheduled to hit movie theaters on March 9th.

Also debuting in February is *Snow White*. It's the classic fairy tale, presented with full-color illustrations originally published in 1883. With the movies *Mirror, Mirror* and *Snow White and the Huntsman* set for release in 2012, here's your chance to see where the current fairy-tale craze began.

April sees the arrival of the graphic novel *Lorelei: Sects and the City*. A fanatical cult attempts to summon ancient gods, and the only thing standing in their way is an adventurous succubus named Lorelei. Will she stop them—or become another blood sacrifice for the cult?

Then, summer welcomes the return of our favorite monster-hunting Goth girl, in *Blood Reign: The Saga of Pandora Zwieback, Book 2*. After the cliffhanger ending of *Blood Feud*, can things get any worse for Pan? (That's a rhetorical question, by the way.)

Finally, October brings *The Saga of Pandora Zwieback Annual #1*, Pan's first comic book adventure. In the aftermath of *Blood Reign*, Pan tries to get her monster-filled life back in some kind of order—but further supernatural dangers ensure that she's not going to get a moment's peace anytime soon.
